ACCOMMODATION INFORMATION

A bit about us:

We are situated on 22 acres approximately 2.5 km from the village centre nestled amongst native and exotic forest at the base of Jacks Pass with walking tracks at our gate and where the lovely sound of bird song fills the air. We are a Family orientated Camping Ground and have a speed limit of 5kph throughout the grounds enabling Children to play in safety.

We have a Smoke Free policy in ALL our buildings.

Our reception offers a range of goodies including ice creams, drinks etc and is open during the following hours: 8:30am – 8:30pm Sunday to Thursday; 8:30am – 9:00pm Friday and Saturday.

In our Bellbird Lodge we offer:

- Large communal lounge area with log burner, (wood, paper and matches supplied), trestle tables (for you to arrange to suit your group), dining chairs, sofa chairs, TV, Video, (we have older style videos in the TV room), and notice board.
- A fully equipped kitchen with pots, pans, cooking utensils, casserole dishes, bowls, platters, cutlery and crockery for 40 people, tea towels, oven mitts, 6 slice toaster, 2 full sized ovens, cook tops, continuous hot water, 2 full sized fridges, 1 stand up freezer, walk in pantry, family sized microwave oven, 2 sinks, cook books, serving trays, dishwashing liquid and dishcloths. Everything you need (except the chief cook, bottle washer and food!).
- Five bedrooms with bunk beds. The bedrooms; Room 1 – sleeps 12, Room 2 – sleeps 4, Room 3 – sleeps 6, Room 4 –sleeps 14, Room 5 – sleeps 4 people. You need to supply your own bedding, e.g. sleeping bag or sheets and duvet, pillowslip and towel.
- Heating is via log burner situated in the lounge area and ducts in wall into bedrooms
- There are also gas BBQ.'s, for the use of Lodge residents (included in the price).
- The Ablution block is approximately 12 metres from the Lodge along a well lit path.
 - It contains 2 showers and toilets in both Men's and Women's (1 wheelchair access toilet and shower in each). The Main Camp ablution block is also available for use if required.
- In our Camp Laundry the facilities include 3 washing machines and 2 dryers, (operated by \$4.00 tokens available from reception), and a Drying Room which can be switched on upon request.

Chalets: We have 4 Chalets

- The Chalets have a queen bed, 2 single beds and a fold out double couch. (The queen bed and fold out couch are in the main living area with the single beds in a separate bedroom).
- The chalets have all linen provided and are fully self-contained including fully equipped kitchen, dining table and chairs, fridge, TV, sofa chairs, shower, toilet and vanity.

Tourist Flats: We have 4 Tourist Flats

- The Tourist Flats have a queen bed, 3 single beds and a fold out double couch.
(The queen bed is in the main living area with the single beds in a separate bedroom).
- Tourist flats have pillows and duvets provided. Occupants need to provide own sheets, pillowslips and towels or you can hire them for \$6.00 per bed.
- The Tourists Flats are fully self-contained including fully equipped kitchen, dining table and chairs, fridge, TV, sofa chairs, shower, toilet and vanity.

Kitchen Cabins: We have 2 Kitchen Cabins

- The Kitchen Cabins have a double bed, a set of bunks and two single beds.
(The double bed is in the main living area with the bunks and two single beds in a separate bedroom).
- Kitchen Cabins have cooking facilities, table and chairs and a fridge

Kitchen Cabin Plus : We have 4 two-room Kitchen Cabin Plus' and 1 three room Kitchen Cabin Plus

- The 4 Cabins have 1 double bed, 3 single beds
(The double bed in the main room and 3 single beds in a separate bedroom.).
- The three room cabin has 2 double beds, 5 single beds
(One double bed in the main living area, a double bed and 1 single bed in one bedroom and 4 single beds in the second bedroom)
- All Kitchen Cabin Plus' have a TV, Fridge, cooking facilities and table and chairs
- All beds have their own pillow and you would need to provide your own bedding (e.g. duvet), sheets, pillowslips and towels.
- Occupants use communal amenities block (with un-metered showers), and other communal facilities.

Non-powered Cabins: We have 4 Non-powered Cabins

- 2 cabins have a double bed and a set of bunks
- 2 cabins have 1 single bed and a set of bunks
- You would need to provide all your own bedding, sheets, pillow and towel. Occupants use Communal Amenities Block (with un-metered showers), and share all other Communal Facilities.

Powered Sites: We have 43 spacious Powered Sites.

Non-powered Sites: We have 49 spacious Non-powered Sites.

Communal Facilities: We pride ourselves on our clean modern facilities.

Our ablution block has un-metered Showers. The camp kitchen includes 2 fridges, upright freezer, 2 ovens, 8 cook tops, 2 microwaves, 6 sinks, 2 zips for boiling water and 2 toasters. We have a separate dining room adjacent to the kitchen. Laundry facilities include 3 washing machines and 2 dryers, (operated by \$4.00 tokens available from reception), and a drying room which is switched on in winter.

We have a separate TV room with video/DVD available for use. A games room with a table tennis table, (we sell ping pong balls for \$1.00 cents each and a \$5.00 bond is required for the pats which will be refunded once they are returned to reception), a pool table (\$2.00 per game,) an air hockey table operation by \$1.00 coins. There is also a Pentanque Court, (\$3.00 hire charge for the Boules). An Adventure Playground also awaits. Adult and child mountain bikes available for hire. Initiative courses at the top of the park. Also check out our Tyre Swings that are dotted around the park. There is a great BBQ. area near our dining room with a gas BBQ. available free of charge. We also have various areas with picnic tables available for your use. An unheated swimming pool (9.5 metres by 4 metres) is open during the summer months from 10am till 9pm. Please note that if the rules are broken the pool will be closed.

What you would need to bring:

- Bedding – most people bring sleeping bags, (or sheets and duvet)
- Extra pillows, if required
- Insect Repellent
